**Inviting Expression of Interest (EOI) for empanelling Agencies as Service Providers for
Remediation/Reclamation of open dump sites**

Suchitwa Mission is the official agency of the Government of Kerala under the Department of Local Self Government authorized to provide technical and financial assistance to the LSGIs for sanitation and waste management schemes utilizing financial assistance from Central and State Governments.

EMPANELMENT OF AGENCIES

Scope of Work

Supporting Local Self Government Institutions in the state of Kerala for Assessment, Evaluation, Design/Plan, Management and Execution of Remediation/Reclamation of existing open waste dump sites. The scope includes (i) A scientific approach to the problem by the agencies, which should address the various issues such as ground water contamination, surface water contamination, odour nuisance, potential fire issues, slope instability of waste mass, emissions and aesthetics. (ii) Methodologies such as (but not limited to) re-profiling of the waste, capping of the waste in accordance with the site conditions etc.

The empanelment will be to ease out the complications in selection of expert agencies for the purpose. The empanelled agencies shall be engaged for the task by the LSGIs through prevailing tender procedures.

Eligibility Criteria

1. The interested entity should essentially meet the following eligibility criteria:
 - a. The agency must possess minimum 5 years experience, expertise and manpower in the area of waste capping or in any such activity pertaining to remediation/reclamation of open waste dump sites.
 - b. Should have a valid Service Tax/VAT/TIN number for the line of business the entity is engaged in.
2. Documents explicitly supporting past experience, list of existing and past clients with full details including services offered, details of similar projects executed, with copies of agreements/work order / relevant documents or photographs, CVs of key personnel, approach and methodology to undertake activities in the scope and other related details to verify all eligibility criteria, must accompany the EoI.

Preparation for submission of EOI

- a) The entity/bidder shall ensure that it fulfills the eligibility criteria and other essential conditions.

- b) The EOI, complete in all respects, must be submitted together with technical proposal and other requisite information and Annexure(s). The EOI should be free from ambiguity, changes or interlineations. Incomplete EOI will not be considered and is liable to be rejected without making any further reference to the entity.
- c) The EOI shall be duly signed on each page by a person authorized by the entity. Documents of the entity authorizing such person must accompany the EOI. Suchitwa Mission reserves the right to reject outright any EOI unsupported by proof of the signatory's authority.
- d) The included Annexure I, II, III & IV shall also be attached along with the technical proposal for furnishing details to evaluate the agency's competency in the field.
- e) Audited Balance sheets for the last 2 consecutive years to be furnished along with the application.
